



GRAND BASEL

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Grand Basel accepts applications for **collectable** automobiles of any make, model and vintage.

The Selection Committee reserves the right to determine the **collectability** based on the following criteria:

- Cultural meaning
- Design quality
- Outstanding conditions
- Unique history
- Limited availability
- Market value

Historical models in preserved pristine condition are favored over fully or partially restored vehicles. Derelicts are accepted if provided in full driving condition.

At its discretion, the Selection Committee refers to its global consultant fellows for confidential expertise concerning historical models.

Regular production models are preferred as a "Grand Basel Edition" – i.e. their equipment including color and trim has been designed exclusively for Grand Basel and the limited edition is initially offered for sale at Grand Basel.

Grand Basel welcomes premieres of future models. Mock-ups and prototypes are accepted for public exhibition areas under the agreement that at least one example of their homologated version must be introduced to the market within the 12 months following Grand Basel.

No visible advertising is accepted on the exhibit, except for all original badging – an exception is made for appropriate racing liveries and custom artwork.

Each application may include any number of exhibits.

Selection of an automobile for any Grand Basel edition does not imply the automatic right to exhibit the same automobile at any of the forthcoming events.

As soon as the selection process is completed, selected vehicles receive a written confirmation of admission.

The decision of the Selection Committee is final and may not be appealed.
