About Art Basel Qatar

Art Basel Qatar launches its inaugural edition with a bold, artist-led format that moves beyond the traditional booth model. The show introduces an open presentation format centered on the theme 'Becoming', which examines transformation in the Gulf through the interplay of tradition and modernity. Guided by the curatorial vision of Artistic Director Wael Shawky, Art Basel Qatar 2026 foregrounds sustained engagement with leading galleries and artists from the Middle East, North Africa, South Asia, and around the world.

Galleries

The inaugural edition brings together 84 presentations by 87 galleries from 31 countries and territories, with more than half of the participating artists hailing from the MENASA region. The Galleries sector unfolds across two key venues, M7 and Doha Design District, presenting solo projects that respond directly to the show's theme.

Special Projects

In parallel, the Special Projects program extends across key sites and cultural venues in Msheireb Downtown Doha, unfolding in close dialogue with the Galleries sector and presenting interventions that engage directly with the environmental, economic, and social shifts shaping contemporary life.

Together, the two sectors anchor Art Basel Qatar firmly within urgent local, regional, and global conversations.








M7 Level Plan
