

The **artkids room** during Art Basel 2022 is presented for the 19th consecutive year by Miami Children's Museum

Miami Children's Museum is dedicated to enriching the lives of all children by fostering a love of learning and enabling them to realize their highest potential. We encourage visitors of all ages to play together, learn, imagine, and create. The Museum is a non-profit educational institution that meets the needs of all children in our multicultural community, and offers interactive exhibits, programs and learning materials related to arts, culture, community, and communication.

As parents enjoy Art Basel, their kids can engage in unique interactive programming in the **artkids room** at the Miami Beach Convention Center. Artkids welcomes children ages 4 and up to stay in the room for up to 3 hours at a time; children younger than 4 may also visit with a caretaker. Advanced registration is highly recommended as space is limited. The **artkids room** is supervised and staffed by Miami Children's Museum employees, volunteers and select artists. Activities will focus on visual and literary arts.

faq's

q: How old do my children need to be to participate?

a: Your child can be any age to enjoy the **artkids room**. In order to be dropped off in the room your child must be 4 years old, if they are younger than 4, they can visit accompanied by a caretaker.

q: How long can my child stay in the room?

a: If you are dropping your child off, they can stay up to 3 hours. If you are accompanying your child, you can stay for as long as you'd like.

q: What activities do you have for the kids?

a: The activities are centered around the arts and literacy. They will paint, draw, create and build in different stations around the room, as well as play art games and take part in art story times.

q: Is there a charge for my kids to be in the room?

a: No, there is no additional charge. The program is a service provided by Miami Children's Museum and Art Basel for parents attending. You may be asked to show your ticket.

q: Do you provide food?

a: No, food is not provided. Please make sure that you pack a non-heat bag lunch or snacks for your child, and make sure that your child's name is clearly marked on the bag.

q: What if there is an emergency. How will you get in touch with me or vice versa?

a: On the registration form you will be asked to provide local contact information, including a cell phone number where you can be reached while visiting Art Basel. In addition, there is a phone in the **artkids room**. You will be given the number when you drop your child off in case you need to reach us.

q: Who staffs the room?

a: Miami Children's Museum staff and volunteers will be in the room at all times.

q: Where is the room located?

a: The room is located in the Miami Beach Convention Center, East Lobby, Level 2 rooms 229A & 228A.
