## Messeplatz

Renowned artist Katharina Grosse will take over the Messeplatz and the surrounding structures with her signature spray gun, transforming the space into a vivid chromatic and shifting environment. Curated by Natalia Grabowska, Curator at Large for Architecture and Site-Specific Projects at Serpentine, London, this thought-provoking work will be one of the standout features of the fair, reflecting a dynamic dialogue between color, architecture, and public space.

Katharina Grosse: "I want to paint the world. I swing my gun and everything it comes into contact with changes color. Color becomes anarchic. It allows me to fight categorizations. It can appear everywhere and pass over borders to turn reality into something entirely liquid. I want to show that possibilities are capable of interpenetrating each other everywhere."

## Parcours

Parcours is Art Basel's unique sector, dedicated to site-specific installations, sculptures, interventions, and performances situated in public spaces and historic locations within the close vicinity of Art Basel.

Curated for the second time by Stefanie Hessler, Director of Swiss Institute (SI) in New York, Art Basel's public art sector unfolds along Clarastrasse up to the Middle Bridge, with an installation on Münsterplatz.

Hessler's concept for Parcours explores the blurry boundaries between nature and artifice. The title 'Second Nature' refers to deeply engrained habits, customs, and rituals. Artists address changing ecologies, incessant loops of information, contemporary rituals, and storytelling throughout the ages and media—from analog and animalistic fables to algorithmically powered narratives shaping nature and culture. They examine the valuation of bodies and life between flesh, commodity, and artifact, as well as sensory perceptions beyond the visual. Presenting 21 ambitious, largely new and site-responsive projects by emerging artists alongside influential historic positions, this edition of Parcours is distinctly intergenerational.

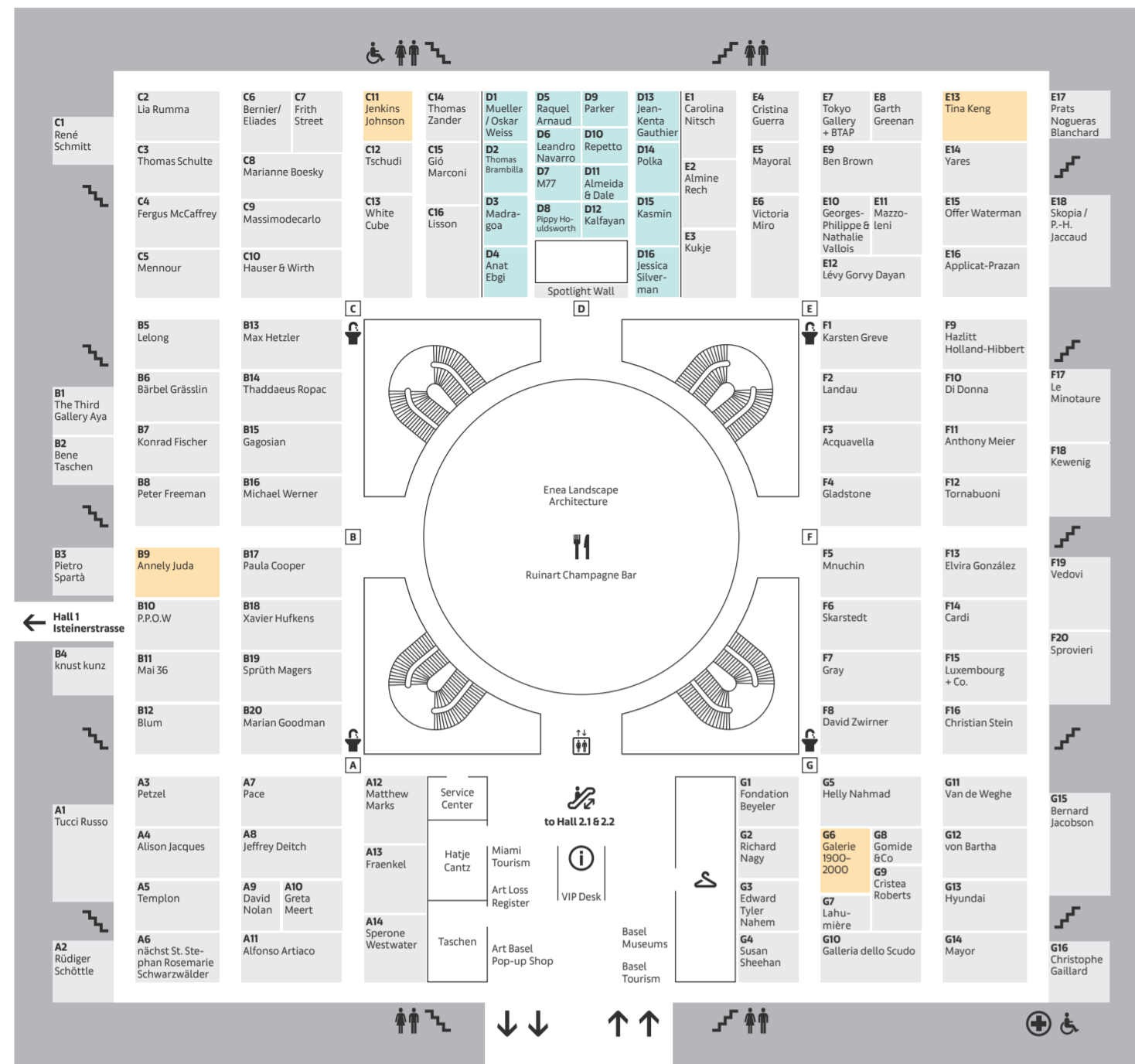
